Turn North on Park Ave

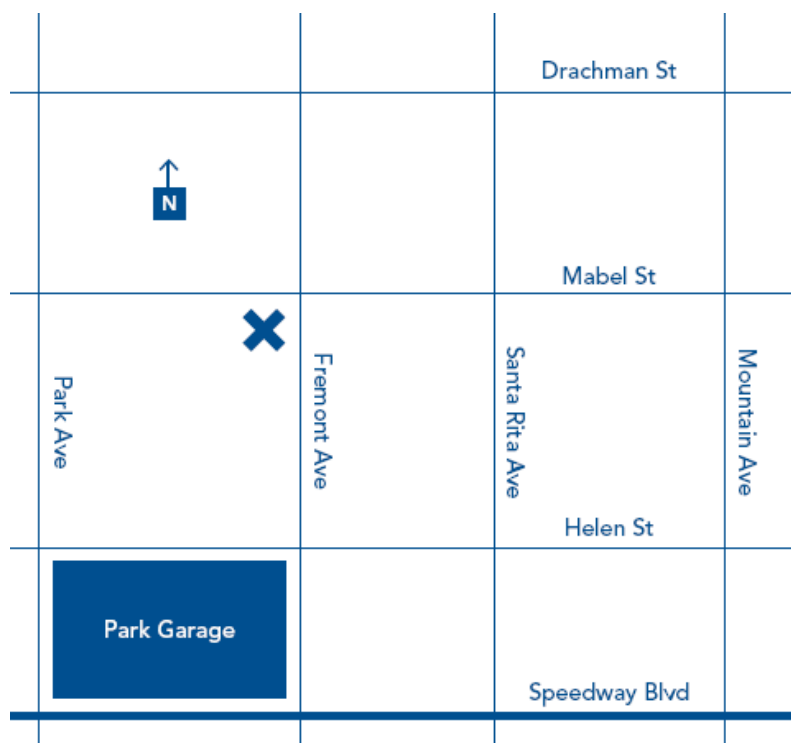
Make a right turn onto Helen St
